

LEAD ADULT CARE WORKER LEVEL 3

This Apprenticeship is for people leading frontline care for vulnerable adults within their own homes, day care centres, residential and nursing homes and other healthcare settings. A Lead Adult Care Worker will make a positive difference to someone's life when they are faced with physical, practical, social, emotional or intellectual challenges. They will be expected to exercise judgement and take appropriate action to support individuals to maintain their independence, dignity and control.
