

IMPROVEMENT PRACTITIONER LEVEL 4

Apprentices will develop the key (Green Belt) knowledge, skills and behaviours to use a range of Lean Six Sigma, project and change management principles, tools and techniques to identify and lead the delivery of change across organisational functions and processes. They will learn how to lead end to end projects, tackling issues that may require swift problem solving, or re-occurring challenges that require in-depth analysis and the implementation of a range of effective and sustainable countermeasures.
