

LEADER IN ADULT CARE LEVEL 5

This Apprenticeship is for people leading the care service and managing teams of carers to look after adults with care needs. A Leader in Adult Care will develop the skills, knowledge and behaviours to manage community or residential based services. The role will have a large element of leadership, with responsibility to ensure the service is safe, effective, caring, responsive to people's needs and well-led. They may be a registered manager of a service, unit, deputy or assistant manager and ensure regulatory compliance of the care given and take responsibility for the values and training of staff within established standards and regulations.
